What is a Parents Interview?

This is a **one-to-one information, advice and guidance session**.

This provides you with an opportunity to meet with a Careers Adviser for a face to face interview. It will provide you with information, advice and guidance to support your son/daughter. Before the session you will have an opportunity to have a chat with a Careers Adviser on the telephone to clarify what you want from the session and answer any queries you have at the time.

How much does it cost?

This costs £49 which includes a pre-diagnosis interview on the telephone followed by a face-to-face interview (one hour). We also do have a limited bursary scheme. Please contact us for further information.

Why do I need to see a Careers Adviser for this service?

Our Careers Advisers are professionally qualified with a Diploma in Careers Guidance and/or QCF level 6 in Careers Guidance and Development. All our Careers Advisers are fully conversant with safeguarding procedures, data protection regulations, local, regional and national labour market information.
